

Fleet Captain

POSITION SUMMARY:

The WSA Fleet Captain is responsible for all on-water activities including the organizing and administration of a series of overnight cruises in regional coastal waters and coordinating the activities of the Race and Day Sail chairs. May include the organizing of a cruise in national or international locations. The Fleet Captain will also serve as either Cruise chair, Race chair or Day Sail chair.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES:

1. Participate in the Board's annual calendar meeting to establish cruise dates.
2. Work closely with skippers to secure participating boats.
3. Develop and maintain a list of qualified skippers and prospective crew members.
4. Document and keep current policies and operating procedures associated with the position.
5. Compile and report to the Awards Committee information related to on the water activities for awards and recognition purposes at annual Awards Dinner.
6. Submit a written annual report of position activities to the Board of Directors by December 31 of each year.
7. Attend all WSA Board meetings as a voting member.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:

Have the time and interest needed to deal with a wide variety of marina managers, harbormasters, and yacht club staffs. Possess keen organizational and marketing skills. Coordination with the Skipper Liaison is a must.
